This is a great chance to buy wines that are not often available at retail and at lower prices than a restaurant would normally charge. Here are a few of my favorites for this week.

2007 Manso de Velasco, Cabernet Sauvignon

From the Torres Family of Spain, their Chilean property makes this beautiful cabernet from 100-year-old pre-Phylloxera Vines. Elegant and smooth tannins. \$35

2015 Caymus Special Select

Plum sauce, blackberry, melted licorice. We made a great buy and passing on the savings! One of the best prices in the country. \$165 \$900 - 6 bottles

2017 Occidental, Pinot Noir

From Steve Kistler, primary red fruits, finishes long with nice tannins. \$65

2009 Cristal Bubbles

Have a bottle of Cristal ready for when we come out of the "stay-at-home". Always a favorite! (97's and 96's across the board for critic scores!) \$195

2015 Domaine Leflaive, Mâcon-Verze

A beautiful white burgundy with flavor of peach and ripe apple, nice acidity. From world's one of the great white Burgundy producers. \$49.50
