SAFETY GUIDELINES

We welcome guests into our dining rooms for the Grasing's experience, however, know that things may be a little different then your last visit.

We have done our best to maintain the integrity of your dining experience while implementing new protocols to meet restrictions outlined for the health and safety of our guests and team members.

Social Distancing:

- Seating capacity has been reduced inside to meet current restrictions.
- Tables have been placed a minimum of size feet apart, when this cannot be achieved protective barriers have been installed.
- We are limiting table size to a maximum of 12 guests, to adhere to the recommendation that no more than three households should be seated together.
- We recommend parties should wait in their vehicle or on a designated spot outside until your table is ready, please call the restaurant at 831-624-6562 to let us know you have arrived. We will call you as soon as your sanitized table is ready.

Personal Protection & Screening:

- Your party will be screened for symptoms upon arrival, this is including but not limited to taking temperatures of all guests before entering the restaurant.
- Face masks* are required when entering the restaurant and when moving around the restaurant to us the restroom or when exiting. Face masks should only be removed once seated at your table and when activity drinking/eating. We are happy to provide a onetime use face mask if you do not have one upon arrival.

*PLEASE NOTE: Face masks are required at Grasing's whether or not you have been vaccinated.

Sanitization & disinfecting:

- Upon entering the restaurant all guests should use the hand sanitizer machine.
- We have moved to disposable menus or online menus until further notice.
- All non-disposable menus have been sanitization after each use and sealed in packing to prevent contamination prior to next use.
- All tables and chairs are sanitized prior to guest seating.

Airflow & Circulation:

- Please note that doors and windows will remain open as much as possible to help circulate fresh air for all guests within the dining room.
- In our dining rooms you might notice a few new items, these have been placed to help purify and circulate the air for our guest and team's safety.
 - Each dining room as been equipped with a <u>Blueair</u> purifier based on the size of the space. These
 machines have been independently tested for their ability to help fight the spread of COVID19.
 - Dining Rooms have also been equipped with multiple <u>GermGuardian</u> HEPA Filter Air Purifiers near entrances/doorways. These machines not only help clean the air but also circulate fresh air into the space.
 - Tables of four or more have been equipped with a <u>Wynd</u> Essential Smart Personal Air Purifier. We understand that sharing a table with individuals outside your household can still make some guests a little weary. These small devices "create a bubble of purified air around you by removing viral aerosols, germs, dust, allergens, smoke, and pollution from your personal space."
 - Our heating systems has been outfitted with MERV13 Platinum filters. These are hospital-grade filters that are recommended for respiratory illness due to their capability to trap 98% of airborne particles.
- Grasing's has consulted with an Environmental Safety/Airflow Specialist, whose work with restaurants in the Monterey area has been featured in several national publications.
